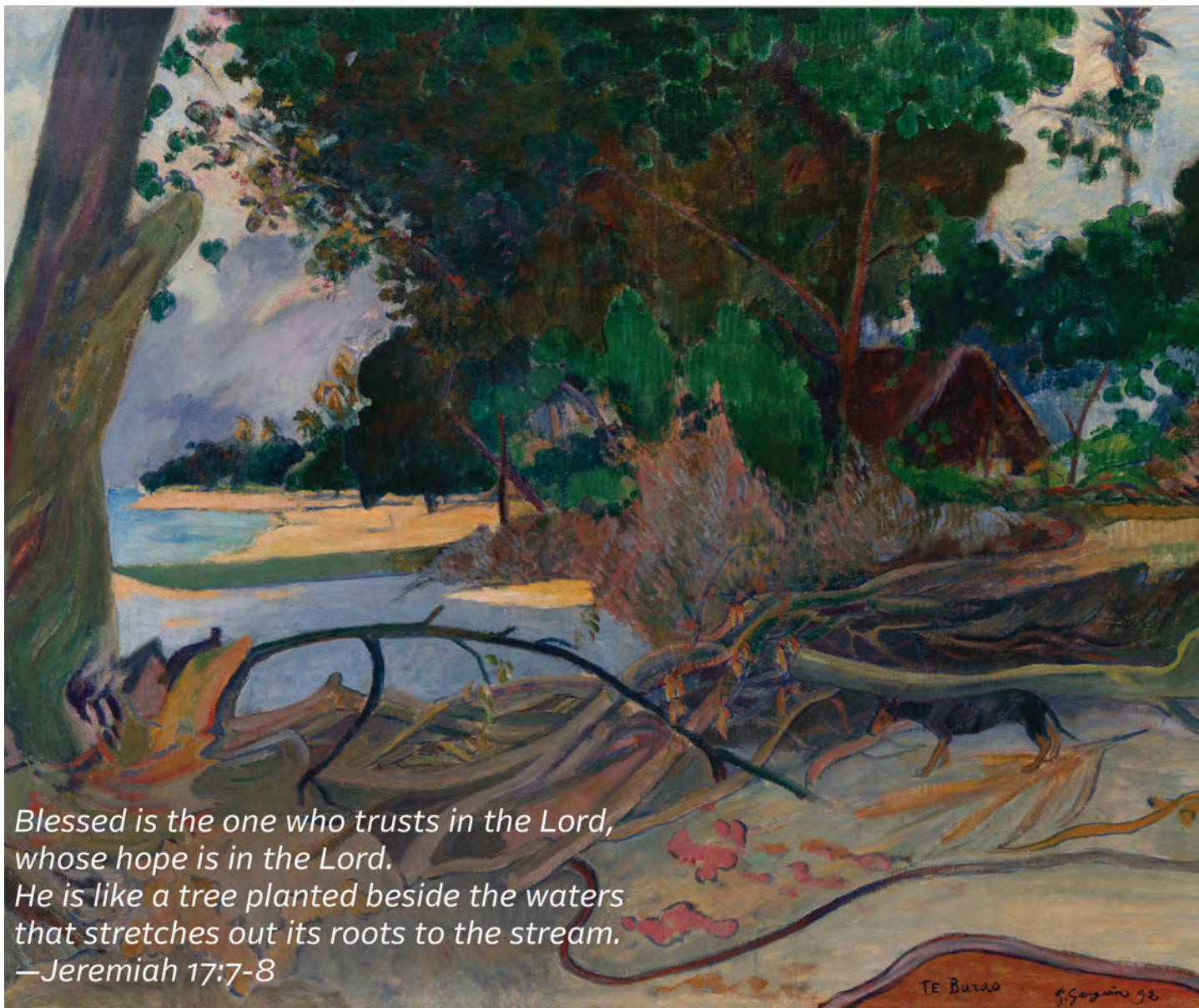

What's Your Attitude?

What is your attitude these days? This is such a broad question because there is much more to the question. "What's your attitude about...and you can basically fill in the blank with anything: "social media," "the Church," "the Olympics," "social justice," or "prayer" the list goes on and on.

This weekend, we hear in Luke's Gospel Jesus' teaching on the beatitudes (to be blessed, happy). We hear a slightly different version from Luke compared to Matthew's translation. Luke decided to add "woes" to it. (I suppose to keep it real instead of everything being so happy like Matthew?)

The beatitudes are one of my favorite teachings from Jesus. As I began to reflect upon my own attitude, the attitudes I have experienced from others, what I have seen on the news, social media and what not, my excitement slowly dissipated. We are all aware of the challenges and struggles that face our world. We do not need to look far to see the woes of our time.

We creatures have good memories, but we don't always remember Jesus' teaching or, we simply don't learn from Him the first time. The "be-attitudes" are a wonderful way to reflect upon our lives and "check-in" with ourselves and our God who loves us beyond what we can imagine. They're our spiritual daily affirmations.

What is your "be-attitude" about Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament? I recently attended an Archdiocesan sponsored webinar about uniting of multi-site parishes, focusing specifically on liturgical ministries. I learned quickly, regardless of whether the parishes united before the pandemic, during the pandemic, or like us, at the start of the pandemic, there is no one model that fits all. There is no timeline. I found it a tad difficult to swallow because with my personality, I wanted the unity to occur yesterday. I needed to change my attitude.

How blessed are we as a new community, as founders of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, with a rich history grounding us by the former SJE and QR communities?

Happy are we because it is truly our Catholic faith that unites us, not necessarily a building or a campus.

Happy are we for we are brothers and sisters in the Lord.

Happy are we who trust in the Lord.

What's your attitude?

In last weekend's bulletin, Fr. Dan challenged and invited us to form a new attitude from "whatever you want to do, Father" to "We are a communion of all the baptized, and each baptized person has a vital role to play in the mission of the Church." What can we do as Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament to encourage each other's role, to change our attitude for the mission of the Church?

As you know, Pope Francis has called for a Synod on Synodality. Please mark your calendars, if you haven't already, to join in the listening session on Saturday, February 26 at SJE. All are invited.

As much as we can, let us rejoice and leap for joy. For this attitude, though not always easy and sometimes may seem impossible, is an attitude that will reap its reward beyond our imagination... *for ours is and will be*, the kingdom of God. Why? Because that's God's attitude of love for us.

Face Masks in Parish and School Facilities

You may be aware that the Office of Catholic Schools has lifted the indoor mask mandate for schools in Lake and Suburban Cook Counties as of Thursday, February 10, 2022.

As well, the Archdiocese of Chicago has stated that beginning Thursday, February 10, archdiocesan churches and chapels in Lake and Suburban Cook Counties (excluding Oak Park and Evanston) can move to mask-optional for all Masses, liturgies and Religious Education classes.

To be clear, archdiocesan and parish offices, including parish halls and social gathering places, must wait until the governor's current statewide mask order is lifted on February 28 before moving to a mask-optional environment.

As always, we will do our best to update you as information becomes available.

And please remember that in all circumstances we are called to love one another and to treat each other with care.

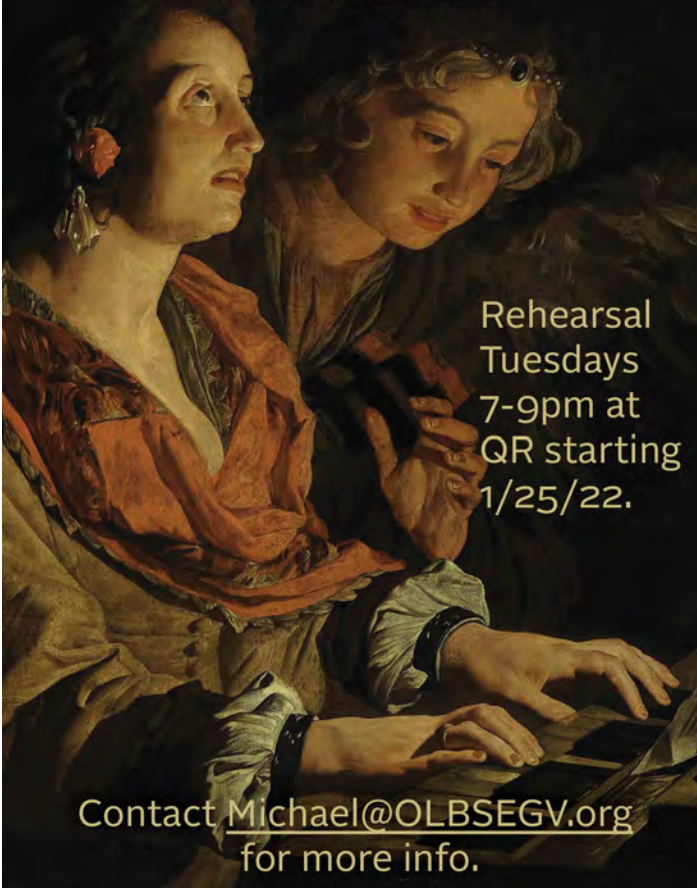

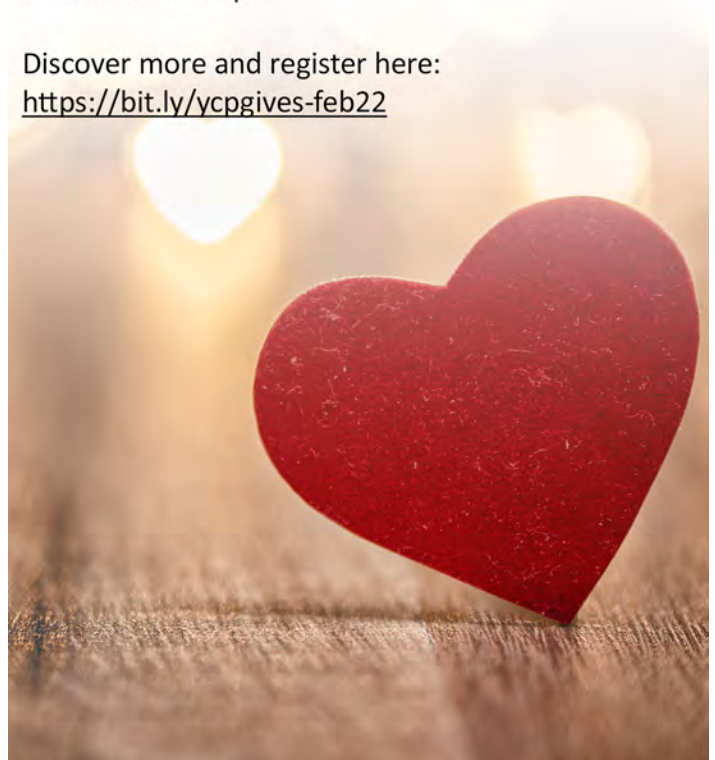

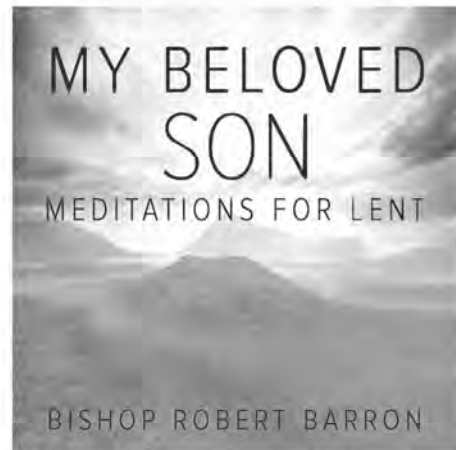
