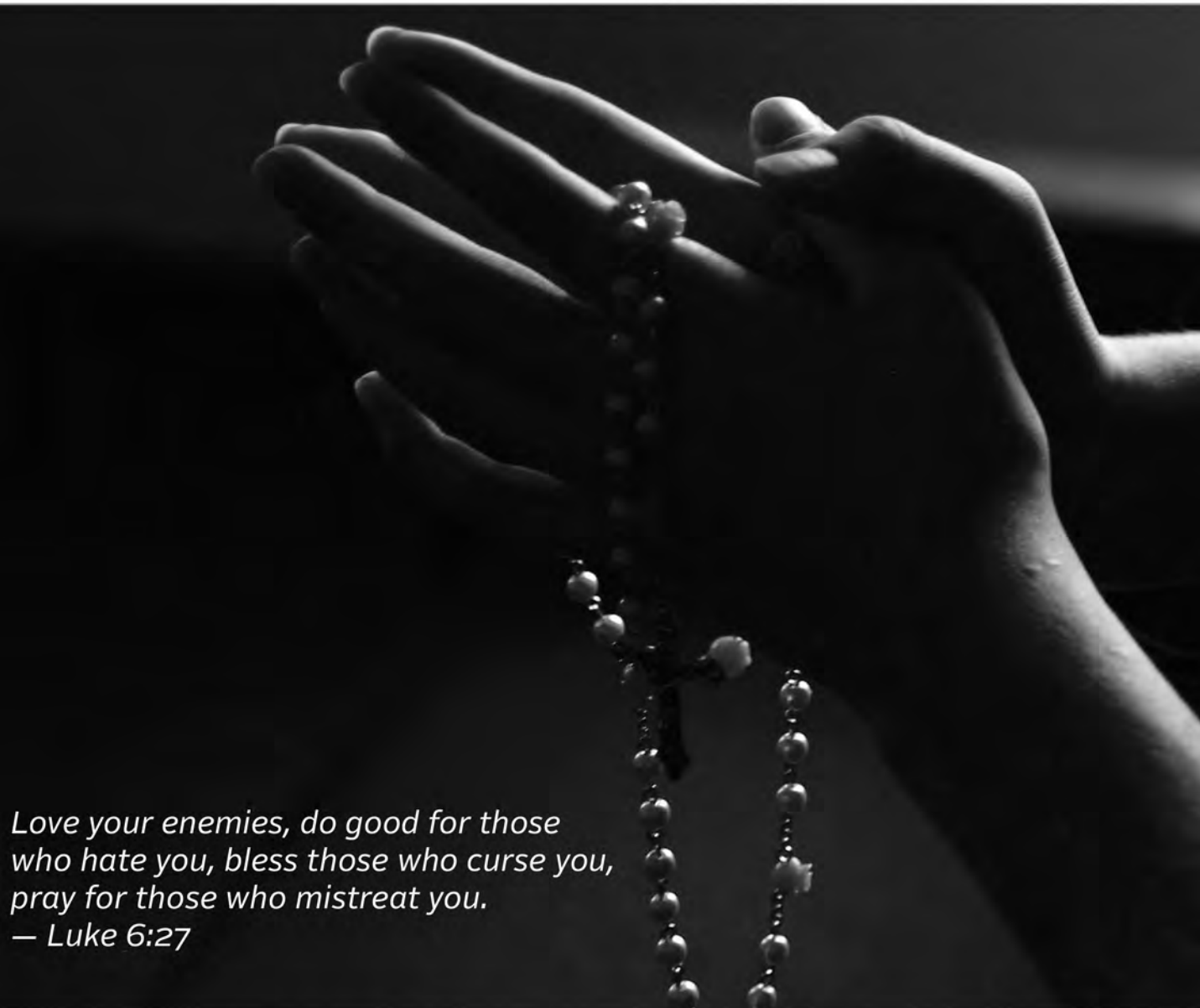

# OLBS Synod Parish Conversation

**Global Reach. Local Focus. An invitation to be part of the church's largest consultation in history...right here at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish.**

Pope Francis believes that only the entire people of God journeying together can answer the question, **"What is the Holy Spirit saying to the church today?"**

Parish communities everywhere are organizing conversations to begin this process of listening for the Spirit. **Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament** is organizing our Parish Listening Event on **Saturday, February 26, 2022** at St. Julian Eymard between 11am and 2pm. We invite you to be part of this day of prayer and sharing where we attempt to hear the voice of the Spirit.

It's important that we hear from parishioners from all walks of life, all ages, and at all different stages of their relationship with the church. So please, even if you feel at some distance from the church right now, consider sharing your experience and hearing what others have to say. In addition, if you know of friends or family members who seem detached from the church, please forward this invitation to them so that their stories may also be heard.

Our Listening Event will begin with Prayer and Adoration from 11 to 11:30am. We will break for lunch and then into small groups for the Listening Workshop from Noon to 2pm. Everyone who attends will be asked to focus on respectful listening; speaking openly and honestly and listening attentively to one another and to the Spirit. Each group will include a facilitator who will help keep the workshop focused on Communion, Participation and Mission as we reflect:

**What are our hopes and dreams for what the church could become?**

**What do we see standing in the way of the church becoming what it needs to be?**

After our Parish Listening Event, a report on what we have heard together will be forwarded to the Archdiocese of Chicago to be combined with insights from other parishes in our diocese. From there, the feedback will be sent to the American Bishops' Conference, who in turn will prepare thoughts that will be discussed by the world's bishops and Pope Francis at a Global Synod in 2023.

We hope you will prayerfully consider being part of this unprecedented effort to hear from all of us to see what the Spirit may asking of our Church today and join **Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish Listening Event:**

## Face Masks in Parish and School Facilities

You may be aware that the Office of Catholic Schools has lifted the indoor mask mandate for schools in Lake and Suburban Cook Counties as of Thursday, February 10, 2022.

As well, the Archdiocese of Chicago has stated that beginning Thursday, February 10, archdiocesan churches and chapels in Lake and Suburban Cook Counties (excluding Oak Park and Evanston) can move to mask-optional for all Masses, liturgies and Religious Education classes.

To be clear, archdiocesan and parish offices, including parish halls and social gathering places, must wait until the governor's current statewide mask order is lifted on February 28 before moving to a mask-optional environment.

As always, we will do our best to update you as information becomes available.

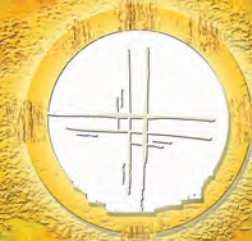

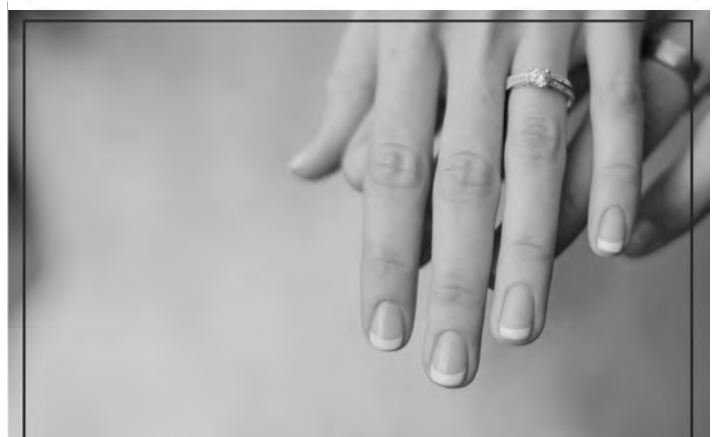

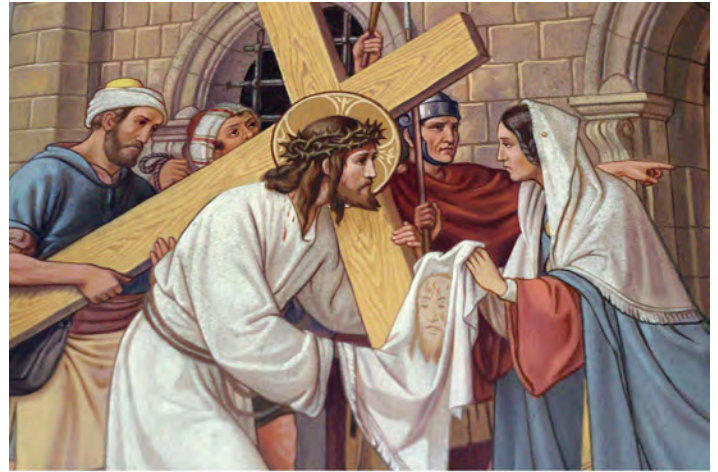
