From the Pastor's Desk...

"Do here in your native place the things that we heard were done in Capernaum!" One of the questions that the Gospel asks us is, "Why do you follow Jesus?" Some people follow him because they misunderstand what kind of king Jesus is, and they think by getting close to him they will share in His power. Others follow Him for a kind of entertainment value—they like seeing the miracles and the wonders He performs. Ultimately, these reasons are not sufficient. His kingdom does not promise us power in this world. Entertainment fades as we hear about the demands on our life the Gospel makes. To follow Jesus, and to persevere in following Jesus, comes down to this: belief that He can save us from our sins and bring us to everlasting life.

As we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, we can also ask the question, "What is the value of Catholic education?" For some people it might be a kind of nostalgia—wearing uniforms, or serving at school Masses. Others may think the value is in the academics, and perhaps doing better in high school or college. These are real, but ultimately they too are not sufficient. The value of Catholic education, I believe, comes down to this: finding an environment where it will be easier for us to become a saint.

To be a saint—in other words, to one day live forever with God in heaven—requires great focus and dedication on our part. I cannot become a saint accidentally. Neither can I become a saint by myself. I need the support and encouragement of a community that also understands that this is the most important thing in life. St. Paul tells us that at the end of all things, faith and hope will fade away because there will be no more need for them. In this life, money, success, power, beauty—they will all fade away. What will be left is love: the love that God has for us, and the love we return to Him.

I am grateful for the community of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish and Queen of the Rosary School and for all those who strive to make sure that our children know what is most important in this life and the next. I am proud of the ways in which we partner with our parents and families to help cultivate both the knowledge of and the desire for God. I am excited for the ways in which we will continue to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ together.

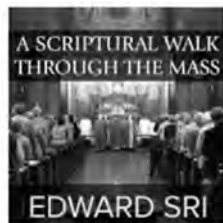
