In recent years there has been a re-emergence of an old heresy called Universalism. It is becoming more popular not only in our culture with the younger generations but also within the various Christian circles. Universalism focuses exclusively on God's love and mercy and ignores that he is also just—that is rewarding good and punishing evil. It teaches that all people will be saved. Since God is good, loving, and merciful, he would not condemn anyone to eternal torment in hell. In other words, everyone manages to go to heaven unless you're someone like Hitler.

This teaching was declared a heresy by the Council of Constantinople in 543 A.D. Throughout the Bible, we are told how God is both loving, merciful, and just. God forgives those who sin that are contrite of heart and repent. He punishes those who sin by rejecting him and his ways for other Gods and refuse to be contrite and repent. Jesus in several passages and parables taught that not everyone will make it to heaven even though it's his Father's desire that he not lose anyone. The Church always taught God is both merciful and just—not just one or the other. Through God's gift of Free Will, it is actually our choice whether we seek God and his mercy or whether we choose not to. God doesn't force us.

Universalism's rise in recent years has been in conjunction with the rise of relativism in our culture. Relativism teaches that there are no truths of what is right or wrong that are absolute. All points of view are equally valid, and that all truth is relative to the individual. In other words, it can depend very often on how you feel.

Those who promote this doctrine feel that we should not be judgmental of any religion, idea, or action of a person. By refusing to call anything right or wrong, universalists and relativists not only cancel the need for Christ's redeeming sacrifice but also the consequence of unrepented sin. Sin becomes minimized or irrelevant. As a result, a number of practices considered unacceptable and immoral in our culture not that long ago are now considered acceptable and in some cases made or declared legal.

There is a saying that there are only two kinds of people: the sinners who think they are saints and the saints who know they are sinners.

Jesus said: "Those who are healthy do not need a physician, but the sick do. I have not come to call the righteous to repentance but sinners" (Luke 5:31-32).

Peter Kreeft, a well-known Catholic Philosopher, had an interesting commentary on this verse that I had not considered before. He said: "In other words, Jesus is saying to you today: "If you say you are not sick, if you say you have no sin, then I'm not your savior, nor your doctor. If you don't open the door of your heart and let me into your soul, into your life.... then I won't come in and you won't have me...I cannot give you my grace and mercy and salvation unless you say no to your pride and admit your need for forgiveness and ask for it. All who seek will find. All who seek God and his forgiveness will find it, but those who will not seek it will not find it." Nothing will be worse than that: to die in unconfessed, unrepented, and unforgiven sin.""

The Gospel readings this week remind us of the need to seek God and his mercy and to repent—that is to change our lives by turning away from sin and towards good. The sign of our repentance will be God's grace working in us doing good deeds—that is to bear fruit.

We tend to live our lives as if there is always going to be a tomorrow. The fact is none of us know which day is our last. God loves us and wants all of us to live with him for eternity. So, God is patiently waiting for us to seek him and his mercy. Since the amount of time we have in this life is unknown, it behooves us to do this sooner rather later. Ultimately the tree that fails to produce fruit is cut down.

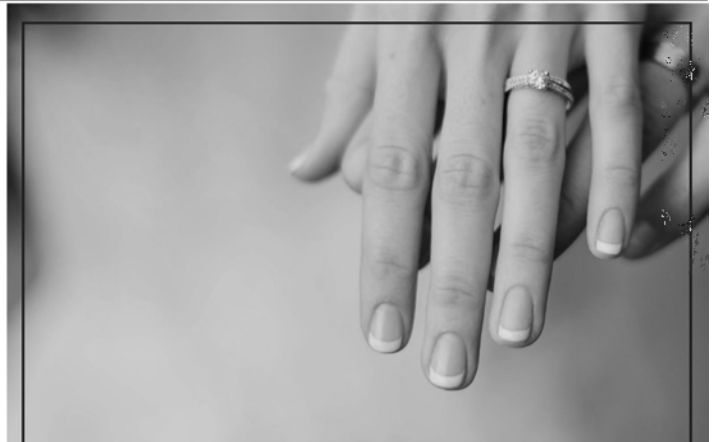
