“I will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who will approach the fount of My Mercy.”

In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble, Polish nun, Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private messages concerning Divine Mercy. He directed Sister Faustina to record these messages in notebooks which later became known as her Diary.

On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Leading up to this year’s celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday on April 24th, fellow parishioners share what the Divine Mercy Chaplet means to them...

I learned how to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet by accident. When I found out that the Blessed Sacrament was exposed for adoration on Friday afternoons for the Divine Mercy prayer group, I could resist stealing that little bit of extra time with the Lord after school each Friday. I would quietly slip into church and sit way in the back hoping to go unnoticed. I didn’t grow up with any sort of devotionals or novenas, so praying that way was very unfamiliar to me and I wasn’t comfortable joining in. I sat back there for a long time, lost in the beauty and devotion of others. Eventually I moved up a few pews, then before I knew it, I was not only praying with them, I stepped in to help lead when they needed help. There was this depth of devotion and sincerity that I was so deeply moved by, and the words were so meaningful.

And I was incredibly grateful when I found myself surprised in the confessional as I was given the Divine Mercy Chaplet as penance! The priest must have heard my surprise because he quickly asked, “Are you familiar with the chaplet?” I was so happy to be able to say yes, and although I still felt unsure exactly how to go about praying it on my own, I quickly searched for it on my phone and, like a toddler taking her first steps alone, I knelt in the pew a little uncertain but enthusiastic as I prayed my penance that evening.

And now, I love how the Divine Mercy Chaplet gives me the perfect words to pray when I find myself overwhelmed and searching for the right words in prayer.

When I hear that someone is dying and I wish that there was something I could do... When I find myself struck by news that is filled with stories of war or unrest... When I visit a cemetery and just want to pray for souls... When I’m struggling to trust in the Lord’s Providence... I pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. How grateful I am that the Lord called me to sit in the back of church on those Friday afternoons and taught me to pray simply by drawing me into the prayer of others. St. Faustina, pray for us! —Chris Nagle

My older sister is a Buddhist who lives in Virginia, but for a long time we were separated by more than that. We had grown up close, but due to some miscommunication between us, our families didn’t speak for 20 years. As a Christian, I apologized, saying, “It is my fault!” I tried calling and sending cards, but my sister never replied. I could only pray!

When Pope Francis proclaimed the 2015-2016 extraordinary Jubilee or Holy Year of Mercy, I felt strongly that merciful God would reconcile us. Then in October, 2015, my sister called out of the blue. Since then, we remain reconciled! —Elizabeth Luong

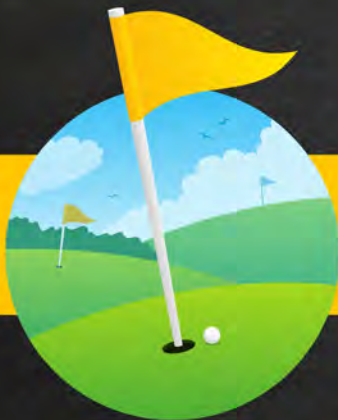

- The Sacrament of Penance before or after Divine Mercy.
- Recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for 9 days, beginning on Good Friday.
- "On the Feast of Mercy, run through the whole world and lead souls that have fainted away to the source of My Mercy. I will heal and strengthen them."
- "I desire that Adoration take place here (in church) for the intention of imploring mercy for the world."



Saint Faustina Kowalska was a Polish nun who received many messages from Jesus throughout her life regarding His great mercy. On Divine Mercy Sunday, April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Sister Faustina and established this feast.

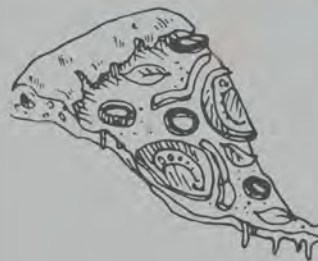
