In today's society with all its influences, it sometimes can be daunting to know just how one is supposed to practice one's faith and not be at complete odds with everything going on in the world at large. Try as we might to be really passionate about our faith and sharing it with others, we can run into the proverbial brick wall. We find ourselves trying to earnestly live our faith and yet it sometimes seems like it's not appreciated, well received or just falling on deaf ears. Or there are occasionally times when it may feel like we're just going through the motions and doing "what's always been done" and we don't seem to be getting anywhere. That's when we know it's time for us to dig deeper and find those moments in our lives again when we felt that Christ was more at the center of things happening in our lives!

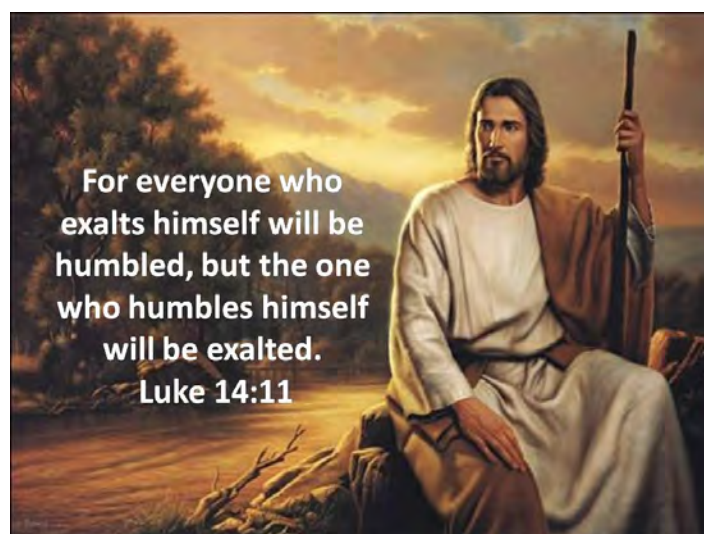
First and foremost, we should never give up! Rather, we should try to find a way to do it better without beating ourselves up about what doesn't happen or what doesn't get done. It's especially easy to get discouraged in this day and age when it seems the world is telling everyone it's ok to be focused on yourself and that your own needs literally top those of anyone else around you, even to the point of justifying the taking of actions that hurt and/or negatively impact others. Many things we encounter today tell us to take what you can get and if others don't agree with you, simply cut them out of your life or "cancel" whatever effect they may have in your life.

The scripture readings this weekend demand a complete 180-degree turn from this obsession with self. The readings are all about humbling yourself for the betterment of others. In this era of selfies and using electronic media to focus on ourselves and our own needs, today's readings encourage us to put those self-directed tendencies to the side and help others. It would greatly behoove us to take seriously the message of today's gospel and decline the temptation to elevate our own importance. As the gospel indicates, we should decline the place of honor or better still offer it to someone else, perhaps one who may never receive

such a gift? If we spend more time denying ourselves and genuinely caring about others (as St. Theresa of Calcutta demonstrated throughout her life), we wouldn't have the time or even the interest in being offended by the things others say and do. That's not to say that you as an individual don't matter or that who you are as a person is unimportant, because nothing could be further from the truth. You are very important, especially in the eyes of God, but the question remains: when did such self-oriented demands become the be-all and end-all focus to the exclusion of all others?

Putting Christ at the center of how we live our lives places a considerably higher challenge in our path that not only seeks for us to put others first but in so doing, also asks us to die to self. If we take up this challenge to put others first, we automatically move towards the loftier goals set out by Christ. If we follow Christ's example, the unimportance of these other artificially elevated "issues" will suddenly seem obvious and we'll then be able to clearly see that our eternal happiness with Christ depends on something so much more important.

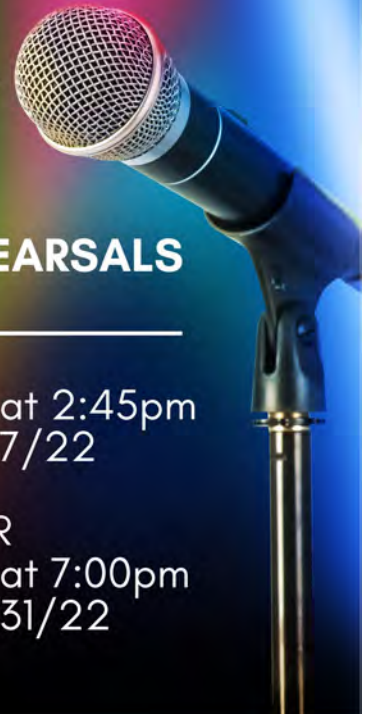

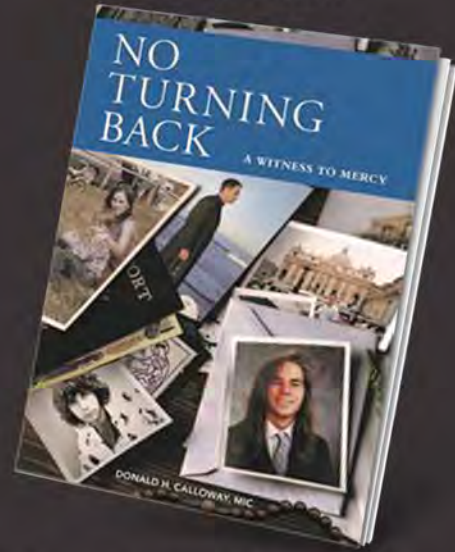
