Some years ago I saw an advertisement (I can't recall the brand or what they were selling) that lamented the fact that after all the preparations for Christmas, there was no special holiday for the time between Christmas Day and New Year's Day. "What a let down!" the ad said. "Can't we find a way to keep the celebration going?" they wondered (by having some sort of sale on their products).

On the one hand, they were exactly correct. The celebration of Christmas shouldn't be just one day! What a waste to stop celebrating on December 26th! Where they were unfortunately ignorant was that the time between Christmas Day and New Year's Day already has a name and a celebration attached to it. This week is called "Christmas."

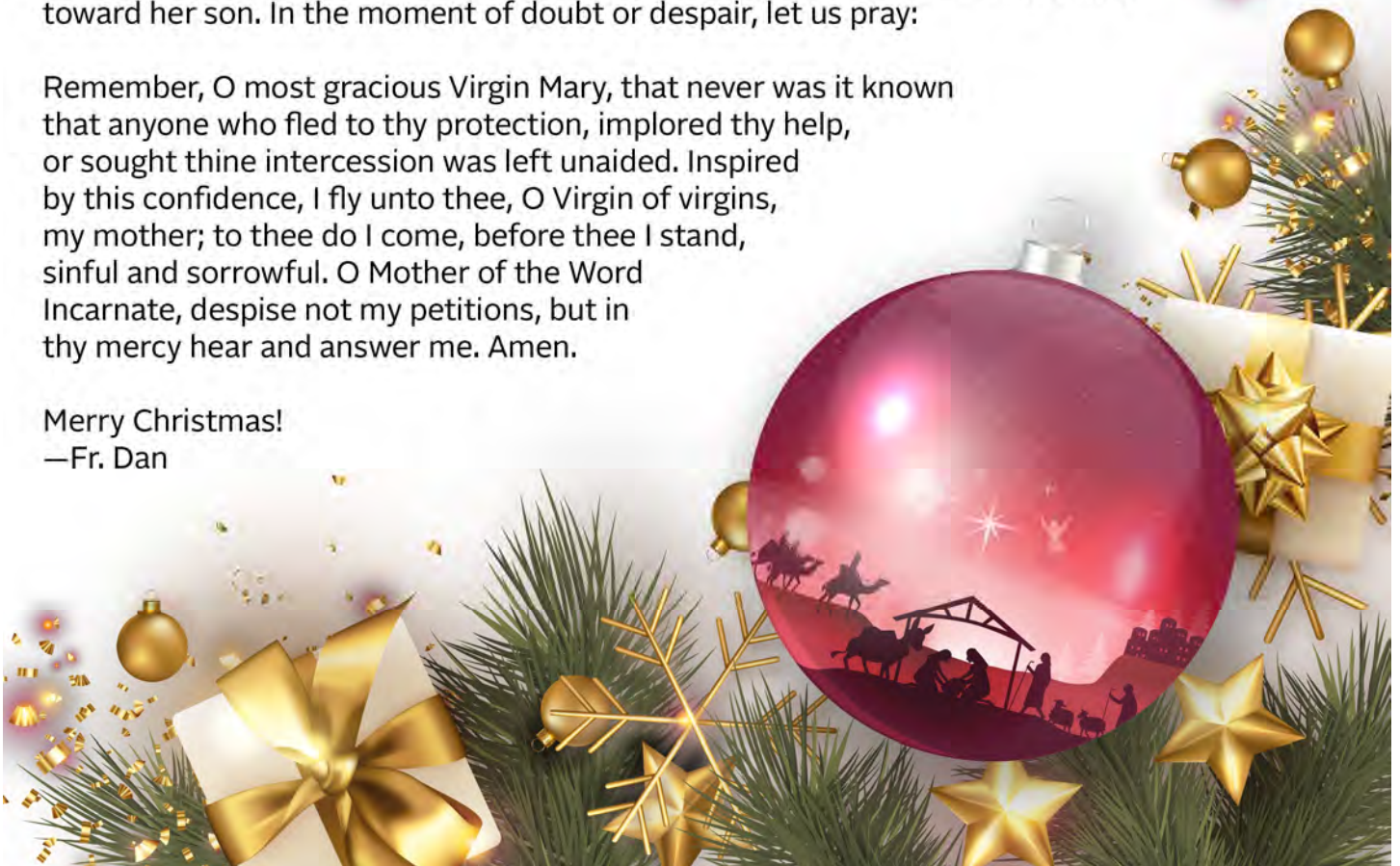
For many people it can be a quieter time of the year. Schools are still out on vacation. Some offices close for the whole week. It is a good time to reflect, even as we continue the celebration of the birth of our savior. We have the same example from our Blessed Mother. We read in the scriptures that she "kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart."

After the joy of the parties and gifts and meals, it's good for us to pause and reflect: what will the birth of Jesus continue to mean for me in this new year? How can I keep making room for him in my heart? How can I further enthrone him in my life? If we are in the habit of making a New Year's Resolution, will I make one for my spiritual growth as well?

If we fear the hill is too steep to climb, let us remember that we have a most beautiful, most gracious, and most powerful Mother who longs to help us on our journey toward her son. In the moment of doubt or despair, let us pray:

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thine intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my mother; to thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

Today is Sunday, the first day of the week. The Gospels tell us that it was on that day that the risen Jesus appeared to his disciples. His victory over death and sin was the starting point of a new creation. Now nothing can be as before. Today is also the beginning of the new year 2023. So here we are starting a new week, a new month, and a new year. And all these beginnings refer us to the first of all, the first day of Genesis in the Bible. On that day, God set out to do something new. Today, He comes to remind us that He wants to involve us all in his creative work.

This New Year 2023 is like a blank page that we must fill out and give our best. The media tells us every day about the people who are suffering from crisis, violence, and exclusion. In some countries, Christians experience absolute horror. To participate in God's creative work is to do everything in favor of peace; it is to contribute together to the creation of a more just and fraternal world.

**It is in view of this mission we came to the manger this Sunday.** We are there with the shepherds of whom today's gospel speaks to us. It has been said that these shepherds were excluded. It is true that they were not seen in the synagogue or in the temple. But if we take a closer look, we discover something important. In the world of the Bible, the shepherd is a very strong symbol. Later, Jesus will present himself as the good Shepherd, the one who wants to gather all mankind. Following the shepherds at the manger of Bethlehem, we all must witness the marvels of God and his love for our world. Like Saint Bernadette of Lourdes (French saint), we are not responsible for **"making people believe"** but for **"telling,"** as the Shepherds did with the people of their time. With the shepherds, we praise and glorify God. We remember that the name of Jesus means "God saves."

Let us begin this new year 2023 by celebrating **Mary as Mother of God and Mother of the Church.** With her, we remember all these events and meditate on them in our hearts. As we are kicking off the new year, we take stock of the past year. There have been some good and difficult times or situations faced personally, in our families, in our parish, nationwide, worldwide. All these events we must read them in the light of the Word of God. All these events must be read in Jesus, he is Emmanuel, God with us, God who makes a covenant with us. With him, the forces of evil cannot prevail.

As we begin the new year 2023, we turn together to the Lord through Mary Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament. The Holy Spirit has been given to us as it was to her. He is always there to show us how to discern the Lord's works in our lives. Mary did not understand everything about Jesus' missionary activity, especially about his crucifixion. **But it is trust that motivates her against everything.** Like Mary, we must not hesitate to admire and question the Lord and above all to trust Him whatever happens. At the beginning of this new year 2023, we do not fail to pray to Her saying: **"Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us poor sinners..."** As it happened during Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth, **if we call Her, She runs to us and Jesus is with Her.**

On this day, we exchange wishes of happiness. Doing so, we follow the wishes of the Jewish tradition we found in today's first reading: "May the Lord bless you and keep you! May the Lord let his face shine upon you and be gracious to you! **May the Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!**" (Nm 6:25-26). This blessing was addressed to the people of the old covenant. It is also addressed to Mary, to the Church, and each one of us. Whatever the trials that will occur during the year, God's blessing is always offered to us. **"Nothing can separate us from his love,"** Saint Paul tells us.

Today we celebrate with joy the brave woman who gave birth to the Savior. We ask Her to open us to his presence and his love. Throughout this new year, we shall do something new for peace, love, and justice. It is at this condition that 2023 will be a good and prosperous year. With Mary and the whole Church, let us raise our prayer to God our Father: **"O Lord, send forth your Spirit and renew the face of the earth."** **Happy New year 2023!!!**
