Dear Friends,

“Come, Holy Spirit!” Pentecost reminds us to call on the Holy Spirit to come and fill and inspire us, not just on one Sunday, but all year through. As we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, I invite you to join me in “Walking on the Road with Jesus” and calling on the Holy Spirit to help make this year’s Annual Catholic Appeal goal a reality.

The Easter season has been a time of immense joy and celebration for our parish community. We have journeyed through the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord, witnessing the profound love He has for each and every one of us. We have experienced the transformative power of His sacrifice and have been called to embrace our mission as His disciples.

As we reflect on the significance of Pentecost, we are reminded of the Holy Spirit pouring down on the disciples, empowering them to go forth and spread the Gospel message to the ends of the earth. This momentous event ignited a fire within their hearts, compelling them to walk on the road with Jesus, just as we are called to do today.

The Annual Catholic Appeal provides us with a tangible opportunity to respond to this call. Through our collective support, we can continue the work of Christ in our parish and beyond, extending His healing, hope and hospitality to those who need it most. Your generous donations enable us to fund essential programs and services that touch the lives of many in our community.

I want to express my heartfelt gratitude to all those who have already made their donations to the Annual Catholic Appeal. Your donation is not only an act of charity, but an investment in our shared faith community. Together, we have already made significant strides towards reaching our goal of \$61,170.00. However, we are still about \$4,000.00 short of this goal, and I kindly ask those who have not yet contributed to consider doing so.

I would also like to remind you that any donations in excess of our goal will be returned to our parish in the form of a rebate. Our practice as Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament has been to use these rebates for special projects around the parish. In 2021, we used the rebate to update the sound systems at both Queen of the Rosary and St. Julian Eymard Churches. In 2022, we earmarked the rebate to upgrade live-streaming

equipment at both worship sites and work on that project will begin shortly. This year, we would like to use rebate funds to install digital screens in the vestibules of both Queen of the Rosary and St. Julian Eymard Churches.

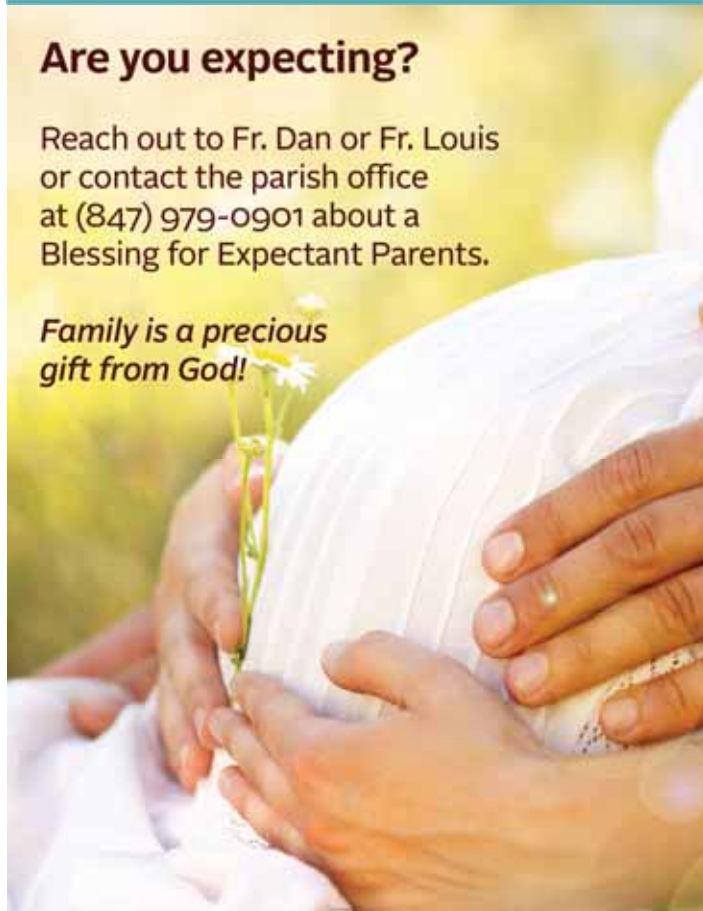

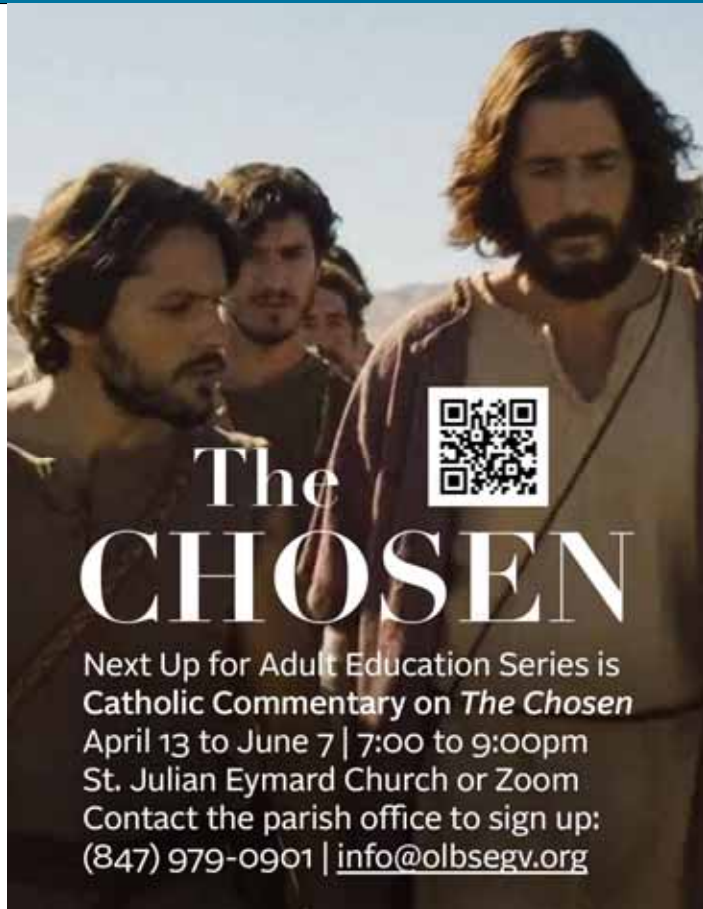
