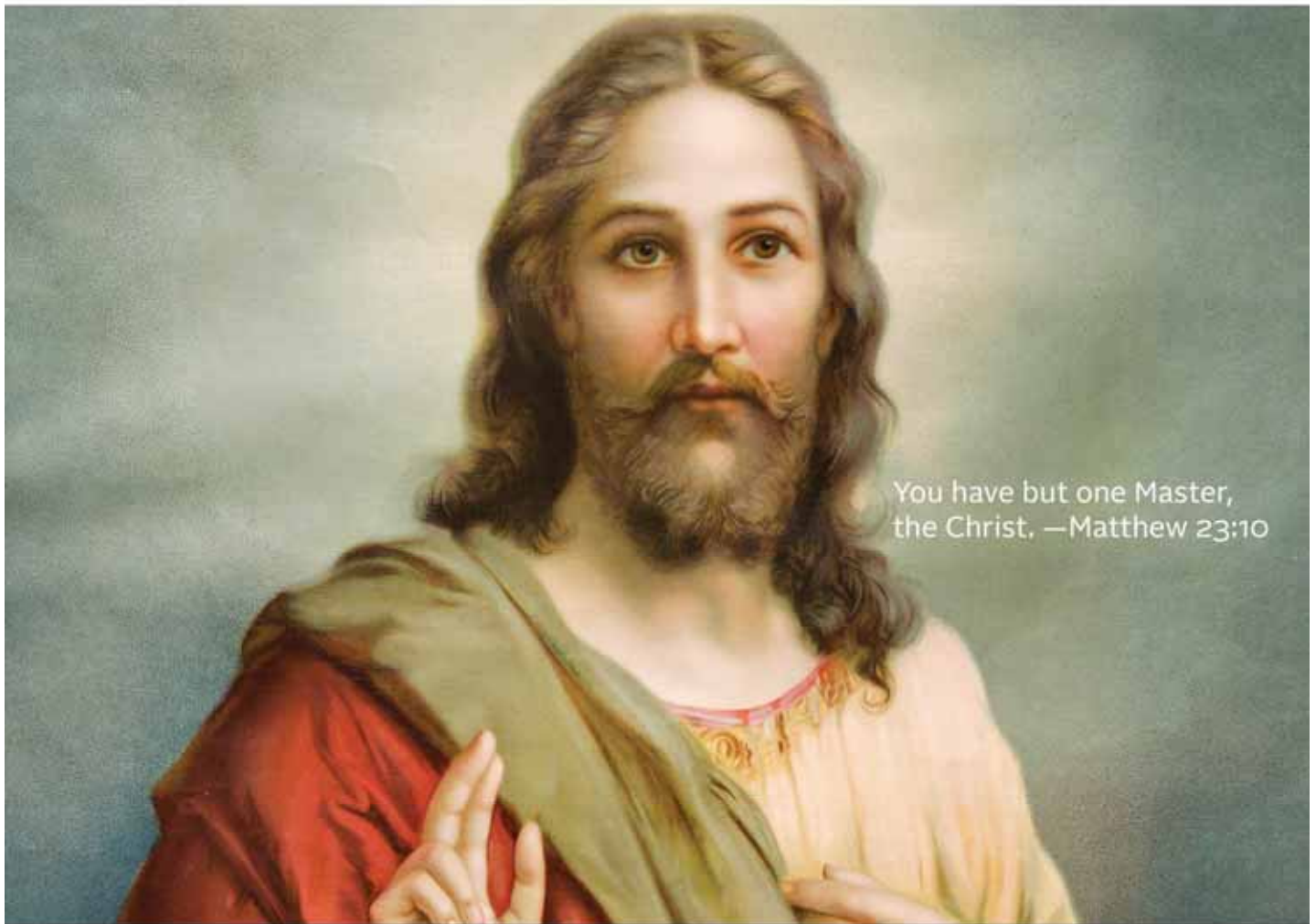

A NOTE ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

These days, we probably do not give much thought to where the materials needed to celebrate a Mass come from: the altar cloths, candles, linens, hosts, wine, water, vessels, and vestments are all already present in the church building, along with extras in the sacristy. But in the early days of the Church, when there were no buildings or sacristies, everything had to be brought by the people. The first Christians brought more than just supplies for Mass, however. They brought everything they had so that it could be equally distributed to all who were in need. According to longstanding Jewish and Roman practices, some contributions of food or money also went to the priests who celebrated the Mass. Eventually, the offering to the celebrant of the Mass also became connected to asking him to offer the Mass for a specific intention.

While the offering to the celebrant of the Mass was intended for his support, over the centuries various abuses crept in. Some unscrupulous priests began taking many Mass offerings and intentions in order to enrich themselves. So, the Church began to regulate them. Some of these regulations are in the Code of Canon Law or set by other Vatican offices, some are set by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops, and some are the local policies of the Archdiocese of Chicago. A few of these are outlined below:

- The customary offering for a Mass intention in the Archdiocese of Chicago is \$10. No one, however, should be refused a request for a Mass intention if they cannot afford it.
- One Mass every Sunday and holyday of obligation is to be offered “pro populo”—for the people of the parish—and no offering is to be accepted for this Mass.
- Separate Masses are to be applied for the intentions of those for whom a single offering, although small, has been given and accepted.
- Masses with more than one intention are permitted only when those making the offering have been explicitly informed and have freely consented to having their intention combined.
- No more than two Masses with "collective" intentions and offerings shall be offered during any given week.

We strive to follow these practices as best as we can, because they help us to remember what Mass really is. The Mass is about joining us to the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, and so it is always of infinite value. Since we are finite beings, however, we can never take in the fullness of it. It is like trying to drink from a firehose. The Mass also connects us, beyond time and space, to the Communion of Saints and the worship of the Angels in Heaven.

Our language and attitude should always reflect this. We are not “buying a Mass card,” as if it were a religious greeting card. We are not paying to have a name announced at Mass, like we might see some group honored on a scoreboard at a sporting event. Mass intentions are an expression of our gratitude, and give us the opportunity to contribute to the good of the Church, and by our offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.

The Mass Intention book for 2024 is open. Mass Intentions may be requested through the parish office, either by visiting in person or calling the office at (847) 979-0901.

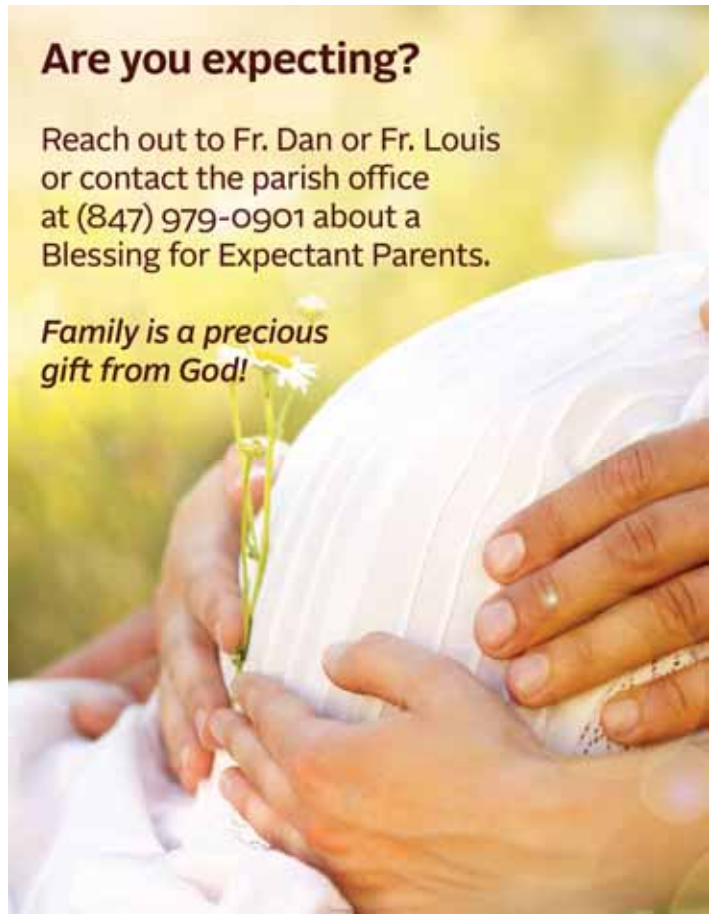
