If you are familiar with the thought experiment of "Schrödinger's cat," then you may understand that I am caught in a similar paradox as I write this: depending on when you read this bulletin article, we may be celebrating the 4th Sunday of Advent, or we may have already begun our celebrations of Christmas. Indeed, if you are in church on the evening of the 23rd, or the morning of the 24th, you may be wondering why there are no Christmas carols, or why all the decorations are not yet in place.

We are always in a great rush to celebrate the feast of Christmas. For the last month (or more), our stores, our homes, and our village have all been decked with lights, trees, and other signs of this holy day. We are jumping at the chance for joy. We are parched for peace. We thirst for the smallest signs of hope and light.

This was just as true in Bethlehem, 2000 years ago. The angel who appeared to the shepherds cried out to them: "Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord!" They rejoiced to see the light and splendor of a choir of angels, singing "Glory to God in the highest!" They rejoiced that God was not ashamed to enter into their humble circumstances, and even to be born as a helpless infant and laid in a feeding trough.

The deep desire for joy, peace, and hope is just as true in Bethlehem this year. But it is not a normal year for them. It has been marked by war, sadness, pain, and death. Last month, the Patriarchs and Heads of the Churches in Jerusalem and the Holy Land stated that they "call upon [their] congregations to stand strong with those facing such afflictions by this year foregoing any unnecessarily festive activities. We likewise encourage our priests and the faithful to focus more on the spiritual meaning of Christmas in their pastoral activities and liturgical celebrations during this period, with all the focus directed at holding in our thoughts our brothers and sisters affected by this war and its consequences, and with fervent prayers for a just and lasting peace for our beloved Holy Land."

The great rush to celebrate Christmas can also mean a great hurry to wrap it up and move on to the next holiday. This year, don't be rushed into taking down your lights, trees, and decorations. On the Church's calendar, the Christmas season this year lasts until January 7th. Traditionally it lasted even longer, until the celebration of "Candlemas" (the feast of the Presentation of the Lord) on February 2nd.

We are very privileged to live in a place where we can freely and easily celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ without fear. Let us keep close to our hearts those who cannot do so in Palestine, in Israel, and around the world. Let us mark these days with an even greater celebration, even more fervor, and even more prayer on behalf of those who cannot.
